## **PINNACLE ACADEMIC COLLEGE – WELLNESS POLICY 2021**

### **Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic we have instituted the following Wellness Requirements**

We at PAC care about our community and want to ensure the safety of everyone. Sick children and adults need to stay in their homes to better recover quickly and completely, this protects them and the wider community.

In order to ensure the safety of our immunocompromised Staff and Students, we require the following;

- Any adult or student or unenrolled child who is showing obvious signs of illness NOT to attend PAC activities including On Campus Drop Off/Pick Up, On Campus Classes and PA Days
- Any adult or student or unenrolled child who has been unwell to be clear of **all** symptoms for 48 hours before again attending any PAC activities including On Campus Drop Off/Pick Up, On Campus Classes and PA Days
- Any adult or student or unenrolled child who has received any vaccination (or lives in close quarters with someone who has) in the previous 14 days to NOT attend PAC activities including On Campus Drop Off/Pick Up, On Campus Classes and PA Days. On Campus students in this position will be placed on the relevant Distance Education Program for this time frame to ensure continuity of education. We suggest that at the beginning of Holiday breaks is a good time to update any family vaccinations so that the 14 days can pass during the holiday break

When students are being signed into PAC, including On Campus Drop Off and PA Days, the Responsible Parent/Guardian/Carer will be required to declare that the student is well and they (including anyone they live in close quarters with) have not received any vaccinations in the previous 14 days at the time of signing in.
